Our Mission

We inspire kids to eat their vegetables. We teach children in low-income elementary schools cooking, nutrition, gardening, and active play to improve our health, environment, and economy.



Why food literacy is needed:



Only 25% of kids are eating the recommended serving of fruits and veggies.



40% of Sacramento children are overweight

Low intake of vegetables in childhood is linked to health problems throughout the lifespan, including allergies, asthma, heart disease, and diabetes.

How we help kids:

- Serve Title 1 schools in the Sacramento area.
- Free, online cooking and nutrition classes.
- Fresh produce distribution to food and nutrition insecure students and their families.
- Bring joy and trauma-informed food literacy teaching approach to promote resilience.
- Inspire kids to eat their vegetables.

Food Literacy Center now sits on a 2.5-acre space featuring a cooking classroom, commercial kitchen, office & training space, and a future 1-acre student garden.

Our new center includes:

- State-of-the-art zero net energy building.
- Cooking classroom for food literacy classes.
- Training and office space for staff and volunteers.
- Commercial kitchen for staff to prep lessons and distributions.
- Community programs: family cooking classes, school field trips, and more.
- Future student gardens with garden beds, orchards, paths, farm animals, and more.
