

Sacramento Food Film Festival Scavenger Hunt

What's on Your Plate is a documentary film about kids and our food system. <u>California Food Literacy Center</u> is a 501c3 nonprofit whose mission is to inspire change today for a healthy, sustainable tomorrow through enduring community food education.

We teach kids about their food system, hoping to instill lifelong healthy habits that are good for their bodies—and for the planet.

<u>What's on Your Plate</u> embodies the spirit of food literacy education. We hope you'll attend the film with your children and continue learning by participating in our scavenger hunt.

This game invites you to explore one of Sacramento's urban neighborhoods, Oak Park, where the <u>Sacramento Food Film Festival</u> is located; where we teach 120 low-income kids about food literacy each week at Capitol Heights Academy; and where access to healthy fruits and vegetables is lacking.

How to Play

Find as many of the scavenger hunt items as you can and complete the scavenger hunt form. Some items can be found in advance of watching the film. For each item found, you will accumulate points. The players with the most points will be placed in a drawing for great prizes, including a \$75 gift card to Biba—and more!

Scavenger hunt forms can be downloaded online any time. You may turn in your completed scavenger hunt sheet at the Guild Theater between **11AM and 8PM on Saturday, March 16, 2013**. Winners will be drawn immediately following the film *Symphony of the Soil* (before the film discussion). Winners do not have to be present to receive their prize, but only those who have provided their full contact information and completed the scavenger hunt are eligible to win.
